From "I want to learn this" to "I can show what I know".

Your Learning Path brings learning goals, planning, materials, assignments, results, evidence and guidance together in one calm learning environment.

The core

You choose what you want to learn, at which level and at what pace. The platform helps you organise the route and make your work visible - without taking learning out of your hands.

Learning starts with your own question.

Your learning wish, not a compulsory course, is the starting point. The portal connects the practical steps from a first goal to a traceable learning result.

What the portal organises

- one or more personal learning goals
- a learning route, agenda and month calendar
- assignments, results and time tracking
- personal and shared learning materials
- a chronological evidence dossier

What the portal does not claim

- evidence does not automatically prove mastery
- a platform certificate is not automatically a legal diploma
- the portal is not a school and gives no legal advice
- AI does not independently decide an assessment

Freedom with structure

Books, websites, videos, personal notes, practical work and projects can be used side by side. The learner remains central.



From curiosity to a demonstrable result.

A learning route does not need to be straight. It should remain clear which choices, activities, results and evidence belong to the goal.

01 Describe your learning wish

What do you want to understand, make or apply?

02 Choose or create a goal

Use a catalogue goal or a private goal.

03 Build your learning route

Plan tasks, milestones, appointments and deadlines.

04 Learn, practise and create

Use suitable sources and record your work.

05 Add a result

Save text, a link or a file as an exact version.

06 Select evidence deliberately

Include only the intended version in your dossier.

07 Have mastery assessed

A formal claim requires a separate independent assessment.

A route may change. Mistakes, corrections and earlier versions can also show how knowledge and skill have grown.

The current pilot is already a complete learning workspace.

The following components were visible on the live website and in the guest demo on 28 July 2026.

Learning goals

Mathematics at mavo, havo and vwo level, plus private goals.

Planning

Learning route, agenda, month calendar, milestones and deadlines.

Time tracking

Compare manually recorded time with planned time.

Assignments

Plan activities, add results and follow their status.

Private library

PDFs, images, videos, links and notebooks.

Flashcards

Create card sets and practise with multiple-choice questions.

Schoolboard

Draw, write, insert formulas and export a PNG.

Evidence dossier

Keep selected result versions with provenance and context.

Certificates

View issued certificates and a public example.

Public library

Use shared materials for fixed learning goals.

Learning together

Forum, goal-based guidance and adult messaging.

Support

Private helpdesk and a personal activity log.

The guest/AI demo is read-only. A personal account is required to save personal data and work.

From intention to a concrete next step.

Planning connects your learning goal to practical activities. Assignments produce results that can later be deliberately selected as evidence.

1. Goal

Choose a fixed or private learning goal.

2. Route

Plan tasks, milestones and check-ins.

3. Work

Complete a personal assignment.

4. Result

Save an exact version of what you made.

Flexible planning

- several active goals at the same time
- learning route, agenda list and month view
- start date, desired end date and progress
- deadlines, check-ins and estimated time

Traceable work

- assignment status and overdue deadlines
- results as text, links or files
- versions remain separately identifiable
- deliberate link to the evidence dossier

The fixed content starts with Mathematics at mavo, havo and vwo level. A private goal can already organise any other subject.

Use the sources that suit the way you learn.

The portal does not put a compulsory course catalogue around you. You collect, create and connect the materials that genuinely help your route.

PDFs and images

Keep documents, explanations, diagrams and photographs private.

Videos and webpages

Collect video links, websites and other useful links.

Notebooks

Write summaries, questions, Markdown notes and formulas.

Flashcards

Combine knowledge, a question and two to four answers.

Digital schoolboard

Draw with pen, shapes, text, images and LaTeX formulas.

Shared library

Management selects materials for fixed learning goals.

Materials can be linked to a learning goal, assignment or planning item. A schoolboard snapshot can become a fixed result version in the dossier.

Record not only that you learned, but how.

The evidence dossier records exactly which result version you deliberately selected. This makes provenance and development visible, but it is not an automatic mastery claim.

Activity

The assignment records what you did.

Result

Text, a link or a file is saved as a version.

Evidence

You deliberately select the intended version.

Assessment

Mastery requires a separate human decision.

What works now

- chronological list of selected evidence items
- exact versions, provenance and integrity information
- certificates page and public example certificate
- download and public verification where a certificate is issued

What a certificate means

- only after independent assessment against visible criteria
- with a clear goal, level, method and responsible role
- not automatically a legally recognised diploma or qualification
- evidence remains distinct from assessment and recognition

AI may later help with explanation and pre-checking, but it does not independently make the final certificate decision.



Guidance where it helps, ownership where it belongs.

Self-directed learning does not mean doing everything alone. The portal keeps contact and permissions tied to a concrete learning goal.

Public forum

Everyone can read; signed-in users with a forum name can participate.

Guidance per goal

Invite an existing verified account and choose precise permissions.

Private messages

Personal conversations in this pilot are intended for adult users.

Private helpdesk

Ask about the website or your learning route in your own environment.

Possible guide permissions

- view and respond
- add materials and notes
- create assignments and flashcards
- give formative progress feedback

Guidance, formative assessment and independent certification are different roles and are not automatically combined.



For self-directed learning and home education - with suitable boundaries.

Your Learning Path is designed as supporting infrastructure for people with their own learning goal. The current pilot begins deliberately small.

Adult independent learners

For professional depth, retraining, research, hobbies or a personal project.

Parents and guardians

To connect a route, materials, assignments and evidence clearly.

Pupils and students

A future audience, with protection suited to age and consent.

Guides and teachers

To view a goal, add materials and provide feedback with permission.

Adults and parents first

Do not yet create an independent test account for a minor. Age and consent rules and parent-child functions are still being developed.

A support tool, not a school

The portal can support self-directed learning and home education, but it is not a school, gives no legal advice and does not automatically award a legally recognised diploma.

Private by default, shared by deliberate choice.

Learning work, guidance and evidence require clear roles, minimal data use and control by the user.

Private by default

Personal goals, the library and the dossier are not automatically public.

Deliberate sharing

Forum posts and public attachments are visible; private files stay separate.

Precise permissions

Guidance is granted or revoked per goal and per permission.

Provenance

Result versions keep context and make sources or assistance traceable.

Sensitive data

Do not send passwords, identity documents or medical information.

Minors

Parental oversight, consent and protected contact are required first.

Responsible use of AI

The announced AI feature is not yet available. If AI is added later, its assistance, limits and influence should remain visible and a human remains responsible.

A working foundation with clear development boundaries.

The live website is further along than the old brochure described. Some important components are still deliberately marked as pilot or future development.

Live and usable

- accounts, guest demo and nine interface languages
- goals, planning, assignments and time tracking
- library, flashcards and schoolboard
- evidence dossier, forum, guidance and helpdesk

Pilot boundaries

- the guest demo is read-only
- adult testers and parents first
- evidence is not automatic mastery
- Premium uses Stripe test data only

Still in development

- AI assistance
- parent-child accounts and age-based rights
- complete independent assessment workflow
- automatic translation of user content

Access during the pilot

Free: almost all current functions. Premium test: €5 per month with guidance from coach Daniel. The listed AI function is not yet available.

Nine interface languages

English, Dutch, German, French, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese, Polish and Turkish.
